  - \* Why Christians were persecuted:
    - (1) The Roman world was steeped in idolatry and sensuality. When the Christians renounced these things, the Romans hated them. Drunken festivals and bloody gladiatorial fights were popular pastimes of the Romans.
    - (2) Christians also affected certain areas of the economy. Because Christianity meant death to the business of making idols, Christians were a sore spot to religious profiteers. Slaves became Christians and so they became trustworthy. They were no longer fit for immoral tasks and dishonesty that their masters demanded of them.
    - (3) The Romans worshipped the emperor (Caesar) as god. Christians refused to worship the Roman emperor.

  - \*Smyrna was an important center of the Roman imperial cult, and anyone refusing to acknowledge Caesar as Lord would certainly be excluded from the guilds. This would mean unemployment and poverty.

- \* Pergamos had established its headquarters at Rome and grew in their ritualistic worship.
- \* When Roman government fell, the church grew even stronger until it became the Roman Catholic Church (Universal Church.) Thyatira was a military town, commercial center, and had many trade guilds.
- \* AD 500-1500 is called "Dark Ages" because learning and civilization regressed. Also called the "Middle Ages."
