

“What Must I Do To Be Saved?”

Acts 16:30

- I. There Must Be Conviction—The Awareness of Our Sins
 - A. John 6:44- *“No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.”*
 - B. John 16:7-11- *“Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.”*

 - II. There Must Be Contrition—The Agony Over Our Sins
 - A. Psalm 51:17- *“The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise.”*
 - B. Psalm 34:18- *“The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.”*

 - III. There Must Be Confession—The Acknowledging of Our Sins
 - A. Romans 10:9- *“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”*
 - B. Romans 10:10- *“For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”*

 - IV. There Must Be Conversion—The Abandoning of Our Sins
 - A. Matthew 18:3- *“And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.”*
 - B. Acts 3:19- *“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord”*
- Acts 26:28- *“Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian.”*
